RE: Parcel Mapping Project Quality Control

Dear Board,

AGIO discovered issues requiring your attention as you consider the final guidelines for the parcel mapping program.

In order to have a successful program we will need a two step quality control process. Step one would involve a technical review/acceptance by the AGIO. Step two would involve a written review/acceptance by the participating county.

Based on our experience there is the potential that some counties applying will be unable to review the data, as it is delivered, due to lack of trained personnel or software. This would mean these counties would be unable to accept or reject a delivery.

Possible options would be as follows:

1) Alter the guidelines to lower the priority of counties that do not have GIS software and or capable personnel, or

2) Require counties in those instances to accept the review of the AGIO and accept delivery, or

3) Request counties in those instances to partner with a neighboring county that has the capability to conduct their review/acceptance, or

4) Devise another strategy to accommodate this situation.
