



### ORDINANCE NO. 75 OF 2009

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF BENTON; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND, FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-40-501, et sed (SUpp. 2005) (the "Enabling Legislation") provides that unincorporated islands of a municipality may be annexed by the governing body of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, an accurate map, Exhibit A, of the land sought to be annexed to the City of Benton is attached to and made part of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, all necessary urban services, such as fire and police protection, are to be extended to such areas within a reasonable period of time; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare for the citizens of Benton to provide immediate Fire protection, Police protection and Animal Control Services to the proposed annexed area; and

WHEREAS, the area to be annexed complies with the standards for lands qualifying for annexation which are set forth in Arkansas Code Annotated Section 14-40-302 et seq. as required by the provisions of the Enabling Legislation; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Planning & Zoning Commission of the City of Benton on November 30, 2009 at 5:30 p.m., regarding this proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2009, a legal notice was published setting out the legal description of the territory proposed to be annexed and all property owners within the area were sent notification by certified mail of their right to appear at the November 30, 2009 public hearing.

WHEREAS, the City of Benton desires to annex certain lands more completely described below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Benton, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1. The following described unincorporated area which is completely surrounded by the city limits of the City of Benton, should be, and is hereby annexed into the City of Benton, Arkansas:

All lands in the Southwest quarter of Section 6, Township 2 South, Range 14 West, that are 2100–feet or less from the western boundary of said Section 6 and are not currently in the Benton, Arkansas city limits as of October 15, 2009.

All lands in the North half of Section 7, Township 2 South Range 14 West, that are 2200 feet or less from the western boundary of said Section 7 and are not currently in the Benton, Arkansas city limits as of October 15, 2009.

SEE ATTACHED MAP LABELED "EXHIBIT A".

SECTION 2. All necessary urban services, such as police and fire protection, shall be extended to such area within a reasonable time. Utility services shall likewise be made available within a reasonable period of time. All property annexed herein shall be zoned R1-7.5 except the following parcels which shall be zoned agricultural, 001-05237-000 & 001-05261-000 which are owned by Phillip Bledsoe.

SECTION 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. It is necessary for the health, safety, and welfare for the citizens of Benton to provide immediate fire protection, police protection and Animal Control services to the proposed annexed area, and any delay in the same adds intolerable inconvenience to the delivery of necessary services to the public. Therefore, an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety. It shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage and approval.


