Sims, his wife, have caused to be filed in the County Court of Lafayette County, Arkansas, a Petition praying for the annexation of certain contiguous territory to the City of Stamps, Arkansas, to-wit, in Lafayette County, Arkansas:

All of Block One and Lots One through Eight of Block Four, and all of East Honeysuckle Drive adjacent to and running in front of Lots One through Eight of Block 4 as shown on a plat representing a revision of the Honeysuckle Height Subdivision recorded in the Plat Book of Lafayette County, Arkansas, Page 87.
