<u>Section 10:</u> The incorporated boundaries of the City of Central City lying in the Greenwood District of Sebastian County, Arkansas are hereby described as follows:

"See legal description attached as Exhibit A".

Section 2: All other provisions of Ordinance 97-7 as may have been amended shall remain in full force and effect except modified herein.

Section 3: This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public, peach and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be full force and affect from and after it's passage and publication.







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### ORDER OF INCORPORATION

On the 17th day of October, 1973, the above styled cause comes on for hearing and the petitioners appear by their duly designated agents, James Simons, Myrle Smithson, Riley Brown, and William Jenkins, and by their attorney, Batchelor & Batchelor by Fines F. Batchelor, Jr. and others of said petitioners appeared in person, and this matter proceeded to hearing upon the petition herein filed, the notice herein and proof of publication thereof, the entire file in this matter and other matters before the Court, the Court being well and sufficiently advised doth find:

This Court has jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter of this litigation.

On or about the 29th day of August, 1973, there was filed with this Court a petition for the Incorporation of Central City, Arkansas, hearing was set for 1:30 p.m. on October 17, 1973 notice of the time and place of said hearing was published for three consecutive weeks in the Greenwood Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation in this County and District, legally qualified to publish legal notices, and proof of such publication has been filed herein.

This hearing was commenced at 1:30 p.m. on October 17, 1973, in the County Courthouse at Greenwood, Arkansas, as set out in notice for this hearing.

Petitions were filed herein for such Incorporation signed by fifty persons who purported to be residents of the area to be Incorporated, and said petitions contained the signatures of twenty or more qualified voters who reside in the area requested to be incorporated; the limits of said Corporation have been accurately described and an accurate map and plat thereof made and filed; the name proposed for said town is Central City, is proper and sufficient to distinguish

and proof presented in open court, it is right and proper that such petition be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE COURT, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, AND ADJUDGED that the Incorporated Town of Central City, Arkansas, be and is hereby Incorporated as an Incorporated Town, of the State of Arkansas, consisting of the following described real estate located in the Greenwood District of Sebastian County, Arkansas, to-wit:

Part of Section 1 of Township 7 North, Part of Section 36, township 8 North, both in Range 31 West, part of Sections 30, 31 and 32 of Township 8 North, and part of Sections 5 and 6 of Township 7 North, all in Range 30 West, all in sebastian County, Arkansas, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the center of Section 1, Township 7 North, Range 31 West, said point being located on the North boundary of Ft. of the inhabitants of the above described area, the clerk of this Court is hereby directed to attach this order to and make it a part of the petition herein filed and prepare two transcripts of this record containing the petition herein filed, the plat of the area to be Incorporated, attach thereto and made a part thereof as Exhibit "A" thereto a copy of the Notice of Hearing herein, a copy of the proof of publication of said Notice, a copy of this order, and the entire record of this Incorporation, duly certified under the official seal of said clerk, and forward one copy thereof to the Secretary of State of the State of Arkansas, and the other transcript shall be delivered to agents for the petitioners, duly certified as a record for said town.

The Incorporated Town of Central City, Arkansas, composed of the above described territory and with above described corporate limits shall, upon delivery of said certified copies be and become an Incorporated Town subject only to statutory rights to contest said Incorporation within the time and in the manner prescribed by law, and shall be organized and governed under the provisions of the laws of the State of Arkansas, and shall organize by election of its officers as provided by the laws of the State of Arkansas, at which time notice of its existence as such shall be taken in all judicial proceedings in this State.

### ORDINANCE NO. 97-7

AN ORDINANCE HAVING FOR IT'S PURPOSE THE ORGANIZATION OF THE TOWN OF CENTRAL CITY, ARKANSAS, INTO A CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS; PROVIDING THAT THE OFFICES OF CITY RECORDER AND TREASURER BE COMBINED; PROVIDING FOR THE DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE MAYOR, RECORDER-TREASURER, AND ALDERMEN; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY ATTORNEY AND THE CITY MARSHAL NOT BE ELECTED BUT APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR WITH THE CONSENT OF THE CITY COUNCIL; DIVIDING THE CITY INTO WARDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Municipal Corporations of the State of Arkansas, has officially declared the Town of Central City to be a City of the Second Class; and,

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Arkansas provide that when an Incorporated Town becomes a City of the Second Class, the town officials become the City officials of the City of the Second Class, to serve as such for the full term of their office, or until their successors are elected and qualified; and,

WHEREAS, the Statutes of the State of Arkansas require a City of the Second Class to be divided into at least three wards,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, ARKANSAS;

SECTION 1. That the City of Central City is hereby declared to be a City of the Second Class.

SECTION 2. The offices of City Recorder and City Treasurer shall be combined and said office shall be termed "City Recorder-Treasurer", and one person shall hold said office.

SECTION 3. The duties of the Mayor, City Recorder-Treasurer and the City Aldermen shall be those duties prescribed by the Statutes of the State of Arkansas and the Ordinances of the City of Central City for such officials.

SECTION 4. As permitted and authorized by Section 14-44-111 of the Statutues of the State of Arkansas and the Ordinances of the City of Central City, the City Marshal shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council. Such appointment shall be upon such terms,

The FIRST WARD shall embrace and comprise the following territory in the City of central City to-wit; All west of Biggs Street (within the corporate lines) all West of Butler Street (within the corporate lines) from Highway 22 north to corporation line.

The SECOND WARD shall embrace and comprise the following territory in the City of Central City to-wit; All east of Butler Street (within the corporate lines) from Highway 22 north to corporation line.

The THIRD WARD shall embrace and comprise the following territory in the City of Central City to-wit; All east of Pierce-Newman Street (within the corporate lines) from Highway 22 north to corporation line.

SECTION 7. At the next election for officials of the City of Central City to be held on the date provided for by the Statutes of the State of Arkansas, the qualified electors of the City of Central City shall elect one Mayor, one Recorder-Treasurer, and two Aldermen from each ward to serve for the terms prescribed by the Statutes of the State of Arkansas for such officers of Cities of the Second Class, or until their successors are elected and qualified for said offices.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Whereas it is necessary for the efficient administration of the municipal government of the City of Central City that the provisions of this Ordinances become effective immediately, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage and publication.

### **Central City Description**

Part of Section 1 of Twonship 7 North. 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#### **Ordinances**

It has become apparent recently that a written explanation of my actions in regards to the recent questions as to the correct city limits of Central City and the questions as to the boundaries of the election wards, should be made. I will approach this in a chronological order so as the events will be clear.

### **City Limits:**

After being asked by you to look into a problem with a local resident being told that she did not live in the city limits and could not vote in the city limits I started to look for the original city limits definitions.

- I was able to locate Central City Ordinance 97-7 in which there were continual references made to "corporate limits" but there was no true indication of what the "corporate limits" were.
- I started gathering available maps and found that there were several different versions of what the city limits were.
- I checked with the Sebastian County Clerk's Office and they advised that they did not have a current map other than those provided by WAPDD (Western Arkansas Planning and Development), and these appeared to be inaccurate. It was noted that there were parts of the trailer park on the West end of the city and a large area of the East end of the city that effected several homes had been mapped as outside the city limits. It was apparent that in order to go to WAPDD and ask them to correct and upgrade their maps it would require more than just me saying that the city limits were what I believed they were.
- I made contact with the Arkansas Secretary of State Office and obtained a copy of the original Order of Incorporation that contained a geographical description of the outer boundaries of Central City. I was also able to obtain photographs of the map that had been submitted at the time of incorporation.
- I assembled a packet with all the information that I had gathered and the facts supporting the correct city limits and provided a copy to you, Vera Combs, Recorder/Treasurer, the Greenwood Office and the Ft Smith office of the Sebastian County Clerk's Office. I sat down with each office and explained my actions and findings and was advised that they felt that this would satisfy their needs as to certain residents being within the city limits and being able to vote again in city elections.
- I made contact with WAPDD and was advised that they felt that there was a problem but had not been able to make contact with anyone within the city to assist with correcting the problem. They were very appreciative in my providing a packet and what information I had. The quickly created a new boundary map, which you approved. They also stated that they would contact HTD Data in Little Rock, that does the statewide mapping, and get the limits corrected.
- I was advised that they would provide a map yearly and send it to Central City for the Mayor's approval and once it had the Mayor's signature it would be placed in their files as a validation of their mapping. I did find one of these maps posted in the hallway that was not signed or returned.

### **Voting Wards:**

I was at city hall on the afternoon of the July City Council meeting and a subject came in to city hall asking for a packet as he intended to run for an Alderman position. When he asked exactly what ward he was in and who he would be running against I referenced the ward map that had been provided during the last election and found that it was very vague and did not specifically identify the information he was asking. I located Central City Ordinance 97-7 which was to provide three (3) wards within the city and was to have set the boundaries for those wards. In reading the ordinance I found that the second ward was not clearly defined and felt that action should be taken so as to prevent any problems in the upcoming election. When I arrived at the City Council Meeting that night I was told that you would not be present so I approached Vera Combs with it immediately upon going into the meeting room. While I was explaining the problem to her. Mike Hamby came in and I started explaining the situation to him. I also provided him a copy of the ordinance and map that I had. During this conversation I started advising him that we had also resolved the question as to the proper city limits but that there was still action that needed to be taken in that something would need to be done along the lines of a further explanation of the proper city limit description by geological terms and not just corporate limits as no one could show factually what the corporate limits were. There were other Aldermen present during this time that were listening to the conversation and a couple of them had participated in the conversation. There was no further conversation that I was involved in regarding the two ordinances that night.

As a result of identifying the shortcomings of the ordinance pertaining to the wards, a special city council meeting was called and an amendment to Ordinance 97-7 was passed to set a proper boundary on the election wards.

As a result of the July 15, 2014 City Council Meeting the following was noted:

- A copy of the unapproved minutes was provided to a local newspaper who then printed a version of events that was <u>flagrantly false</u>. It is not understood why the minutes were released when they had not been approved by the council. The account of events appeared as though there was arguing going during the conversation, which was <u>not true</u>. It also indicated that I waited to bring this matter up until after the meeting which was also <u>not true</u>.
- A <u>special meeting</u> was held and Ordinance 97-7 was updated to give proper boundary definitions of the wards only.
- It is unknown as to why the problems that were found took so long to surface. In the first situation I was simply doing as you instructed. In the second situation I did not find out until late in the afternoon and was going to provide the information to you at the meeting but instead presented it to Vera Combs, so she could present it to the council immediately, as she was in charge of the meeting that night. She did not pursue it any further in the meeting.
- There STILL needs to be an amendment or some other action made to correct the
  problem with the vague ordinance which sets out the city limits when Central City was
  changed to a City of the Second Class. This could potentially affect taxes, public services
  and other civil benefits. Failure to act on this could present problems in the future.

When I arrived at the City Council Meeting that night I was told that you would not be present so I approached Vera Combs with it immediately upon going into the meeting room. While I was explaining the problem to her, Mike Hamby came in and I started explaining the situation to him. I also provided him a copy of the ordinance and map that I had. During this conversation I started advising him that we had also resolved the question as to the proper city limits but that there was still action that needed to be taken in that something would need to be done along the lines of a further explanation of the proper city limit description by geological terms and not just corporate limits as no one could show factually what the corporate limits were. There were other Aldermen present during this time that were listening to the conversation and a couple of them had participated in the conversation. There was no further conversation that I was involved in regarding the two ordinances that night.

As a result of identifying the shortcomings of the ordinance pertaining to the wards, a special city council meeting was called and an amendment to Ordinance 97-7 was passed to set a proper boundary on the election wards.

As a result of the July 15, 2014 City Council Meeting the following was noted:

- A copy of the unapproved minutes was provided to a local newspaper who then
  printed a version of events that was <u>flagrantly false</u>. It is not understood why the
  minutes were released when they had not been approved by the council. The
  account of events appeared as though there was arguing going on during the
  conversation, which was <u>not true</u>. It also indicated that I waited to bring this
  matter up until after the meeting which was also <u>not true</u>.
- A <u>special meeting</u> was held and Ordinance 97-7 was updated to give proper boundary definitions of the wards only.
- It is unknown as to why the problems that were found took so long to surface. In
  the first situation I was simply doing as you instructed. In the second situation I
  did not find out until late in the afternoon and was going to provide the
  information to you at the meeting but instead presented it to Vera Combs, so
  she could present it to the council immediately, as she was in charge of the
  meeting that night. She did not pursue it any further in the meeting.
- There STILL needs to be an amendment or some other action made to correct
  the problem with the vague ordinance which sets out the city limits when
  Central City was changed to a City of the Second Class. This could potentially
  affect taxes, public services and other civil benefits. Failure to act on this could
  present problems in the future.
