On this 13th day of October, 2003, the above styled matter came on for consideration by the Court upon the Petition of Kenneth O. Nicholson, Cynthia J. Nicholson, Glenda V. Carpenter and Janie Garland, to annex to the City of Pleasant Plains, Arkansas, the following described property:

A tract of land being part of the NE1/4 of the NW1/4 and part of the NW1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 27 in Township 11 North, Range 6 West of the 5th Principal Meridian in Independence County, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stone monument found at the Northeast Corner of said NE1/4, NW1/4; thence run South 00 degrees 31 minutes 25 seconds West along the East Line of said NE1/4, NW1/4, a distance of 126.33 feet; thence run North 89 degrees 26 minutes 00 seconds East, a distance of 214.90 feet to the West Right-Of-Way Line of U.S. Highway 167; thence run South 20 degrees 26 minutes 39 seconds West along said West Right-Of-Way Line, a distance of 554.60 feet; thence run along said West Right-Of-Way Line on a curve to the left having a 1192.24 foot radius, a curve distance of 248.74 feet; thence run North 89 degrees 32 minutes 07 seconds West, a distance of 431.12 feet; thence run South 00 degrees 34 minutes 39 seconds East, a distance of 416.25 feet to the North Right-Of-Way Line of Arkansas Highway 87; thence run North 89 degrees 32 minutes 07 seconds West along said North Right-Of-Way Line, a distance of 866.54 feet to a fence corner; thence run North 00 degrees 00 minutes 53 seconds West along a fence, a distance of 1285.18 feet to a fence corner; thence run North 89 degrees 47 minutes 37 seconds East along a fence, a distance of 1335.75 feet to the Point of Beginning. Containing 36.45 acres, more or less.
